# Fyndiq WooCommerce Plugin

Installation Instructions Version 1.0.0

## Introduction

This document details the necessary steps to install the Fyndiq Plugin for WooCommerce.

### **Background**

This document outlines how to install the Fyndiq Plugin for the WooCommerce E-Commerce Platform.

#### **Prerequisites**

This document assumes that the following requirements are met before installing the plugin:

- WooCommerce version 2.2-2.4
- WordPress 4.0 or later
- PHP version is >= 5.6
- MySQL version is >= 5.5
- Proper access to the WordPress installation is available, so the plugin can be installed
- A merchant account has been created on Fyndiq
- An API V2 token has been created for that account on the Fyndiq Merchant Pages

Since the plugin is still in Public Beta, your Fyndiq Merchant Account has to be manually activated to support it. To do this, please contact Merchant Support stating the account name you would like to use with the WooCommerce Plugin.

**Please note:** Your account will stay in test mode until your first product upload has been completed. Please contact Merchant Support again as soon as your first products are uploaded correctly and you are ready to start selling or whenever questions or problems come up.

### Installation through Wordpress Plugin Manager

- 1. Select *Plugins* from the Wordpress Main Menu. If you do not have access to that menu, please contact your Wordpress Administrator.
- 2. On the top of the Plugin Manager page, please click the *Add New* button
- 3. On the top of the page, please click the *Upload* button
- 4. Download the Fyndig Plugin from http://developers.fyndig.com/fyndig-built-integrations/
- 5. Locate the downloaded file and select it for upload
- 6. Click the *Install Now* button
- 7. Activate the Fyndiq Plugin by clicking **Activate**.
- 8. Setup the plugin easily by going to *WooCommerce -> Settings -> Products -> Fyndiq* (you find the *Fyndiq* section in the small submenu on the *Products*' page). There you insert your *username* and your *API V2 token* generated on the Fyndiq Merchant Pages in order to make the plugin work. Moreover, you set the *Global Price Percentage*. Global price percentage is the default percentage discount applied on products available on Fyndiq. If there is a need to change the *Order Status* that applies to orders imported from Fyndiq, it should be changed accordingly. Then click on **Save changes**.

**Please note:** To being able to use this plugin, a valid Fyndiq API V2 Token is required. To generate a token, your Merchant Account has to be activated. - 10. Please continue getting started the Fyndiq WooCommerce Plugin as described in the User Guide included with the plugin. In case of questions or problems, please contact Merchant Support.

#### Manual installation

- 1. Download the Fyndiq Plugin from <a href="http://developers.fyndiq.com/fyndiq-built-integrations/">http://developers.fyndiq.com/fyndiq-built-integrations/</a>
- 2. Unzip the zip-file. You easily do that by using the built-in file extraction software in your Operating System. You will then have a directory called "fyndig-woocommerce".
- 3. Move the unzipped directory "fyndiq-woocommerce" to your WordPress installation's directory. It is usually called *wp-content/plugins*.
- 4. Activate the Fyndiq Plugin as any other plugin by selecting **Plugins** from left side menu on WordPress Admin page. Find the newly uploaded plugin in the list and click **Activate**.
- 5. Setup the plugin easily by going to *WooCommerce -> Settings -> Products -> Fyndiq* (you find the *Fyndiq* section in the small submenu on the *Products*' page). There you insert your *username* and your *API V2 token* generated on the Fyndiq Merchant Pages in order to make the plugin work. Moreover, you set the *Global Price Percentage*. Global price percentage is the default percentage discount applied on products available on Fyndiq. If there is a need to change the *Order Status* that applies to orders imported from Fyndiq, it should be changed accordingly. Then click on **Save changes**.
